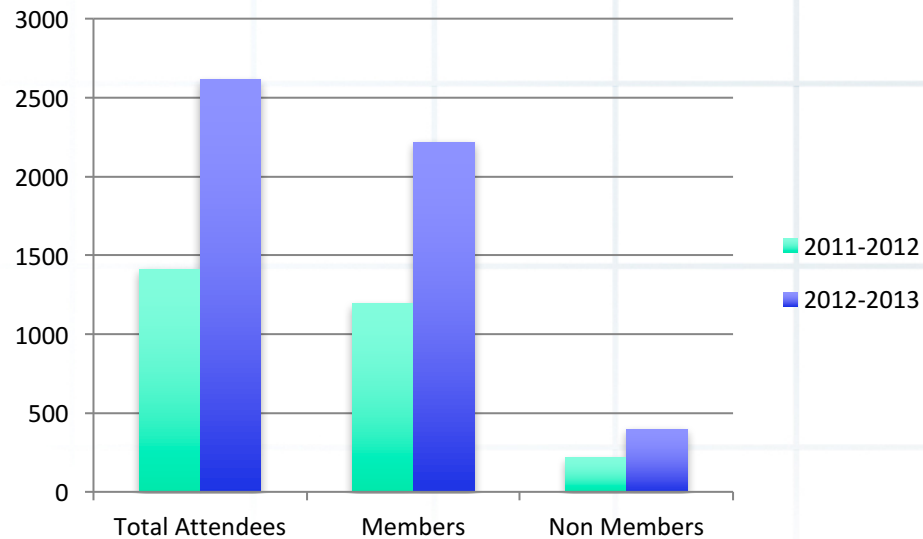
Global Ends Statement

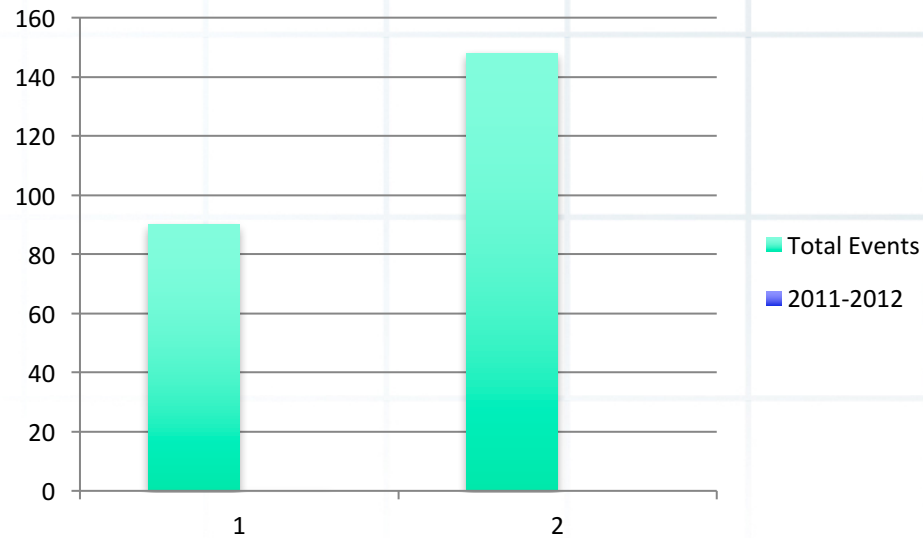
Event Attendance Report

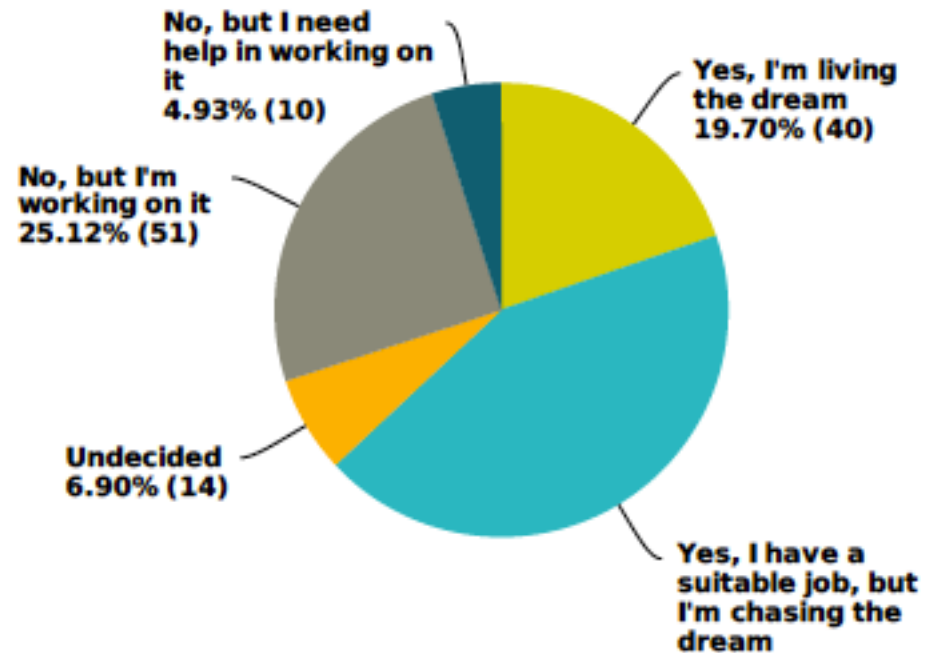

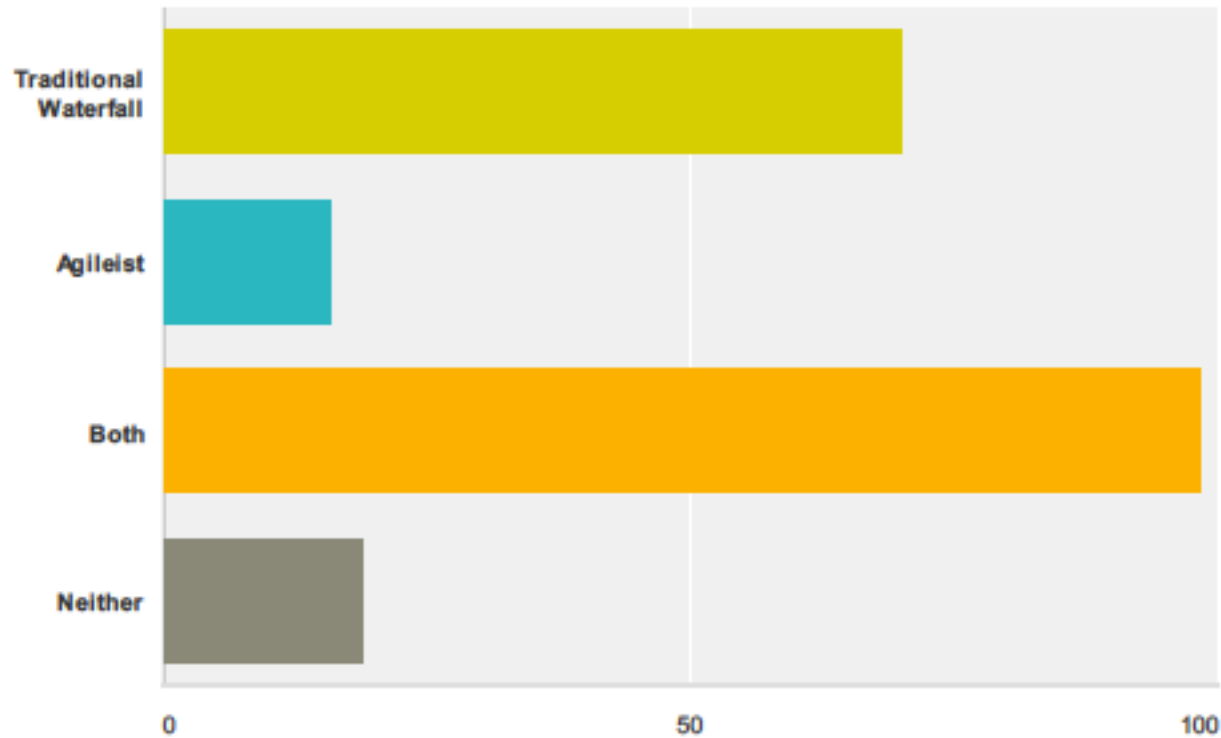

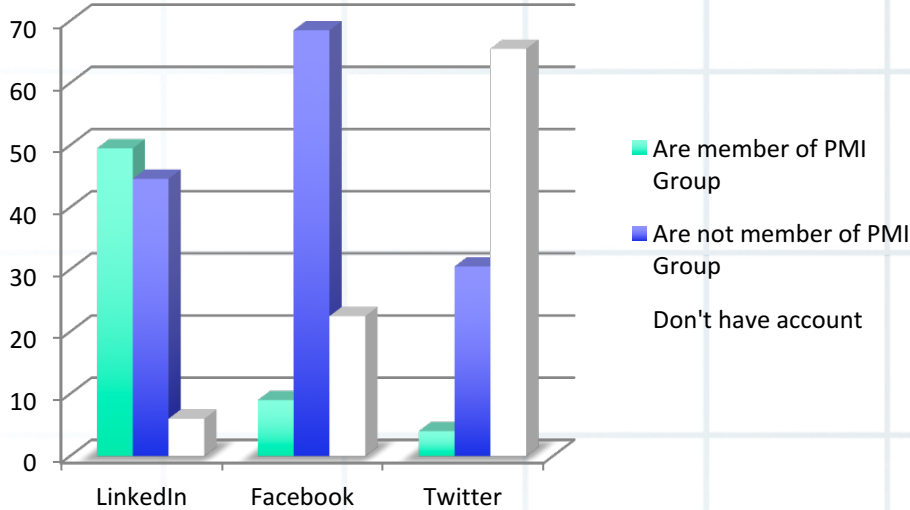
Survey results “Have job you want”

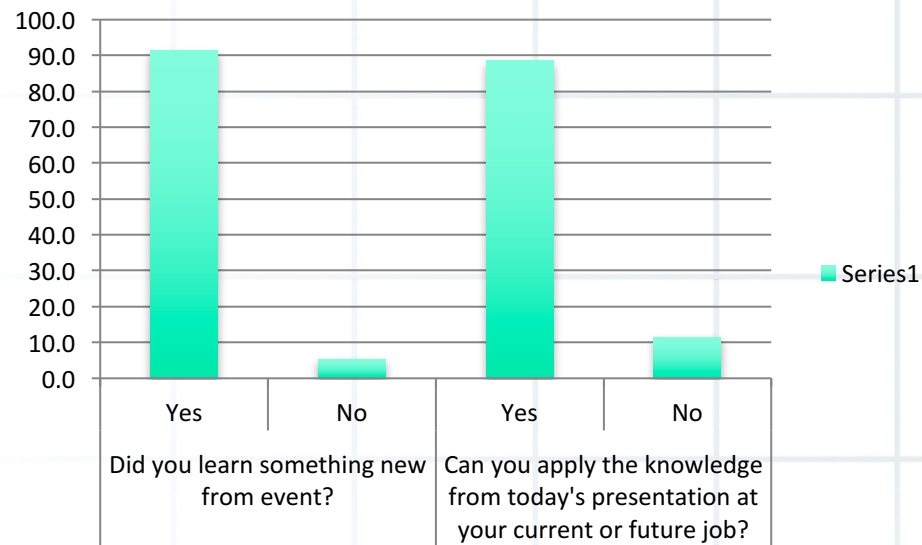
When asked – “in your opinion. what is the easiest way for you to feel part of the community”

2. Attend networking events such as evening program.

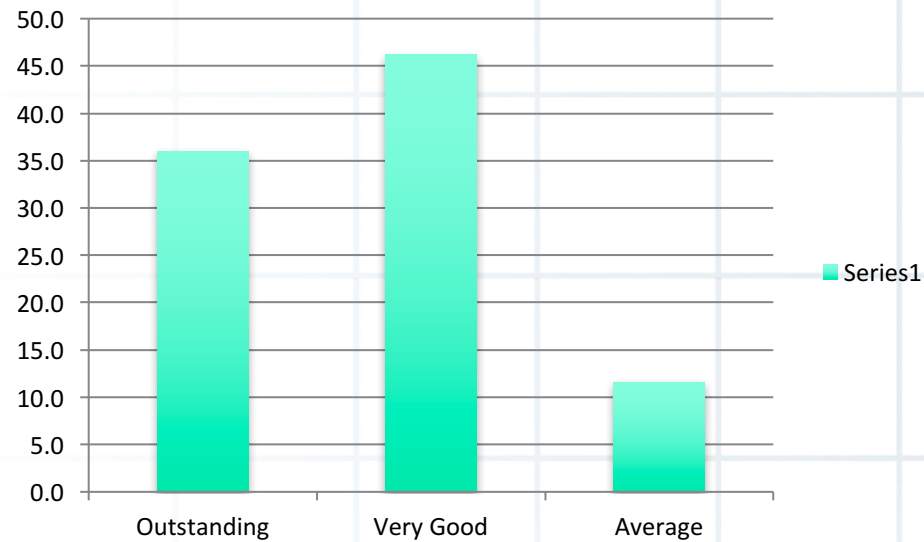
Survey results “Knowledge to be successful”

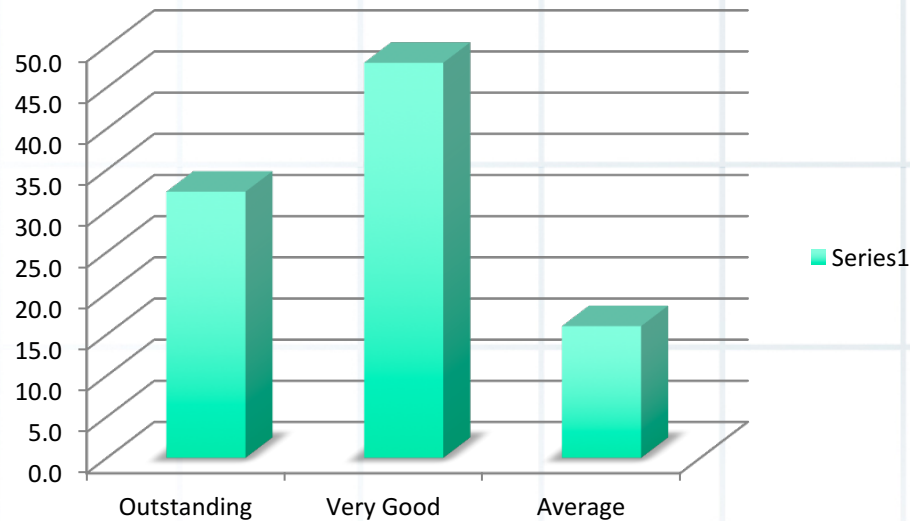
Survey results “Knowledge to be successful”

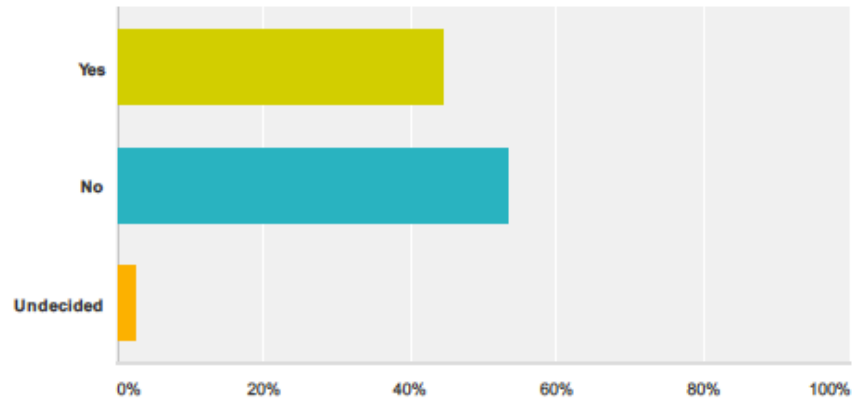
How would you rate the content of the presentation/class?



Annual survey results “sense of community”

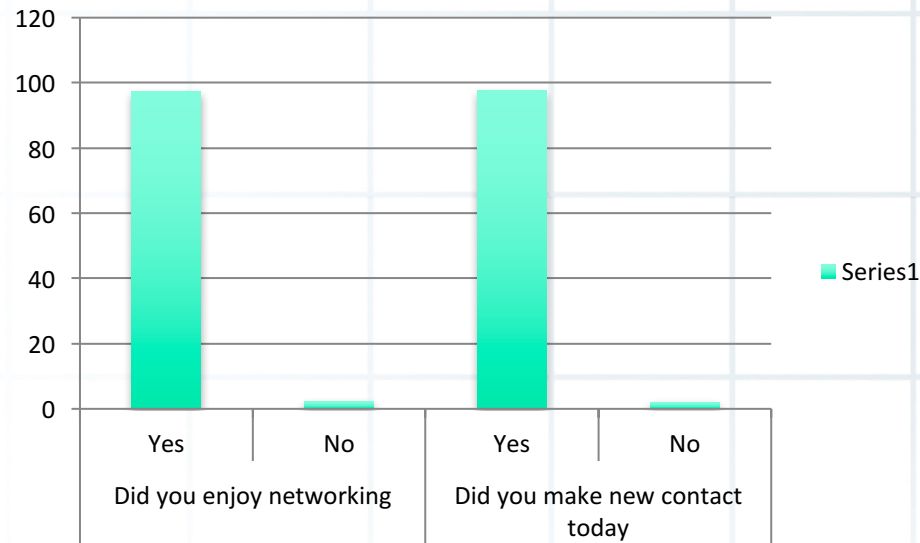

Survey results by attendees of the event on Networking

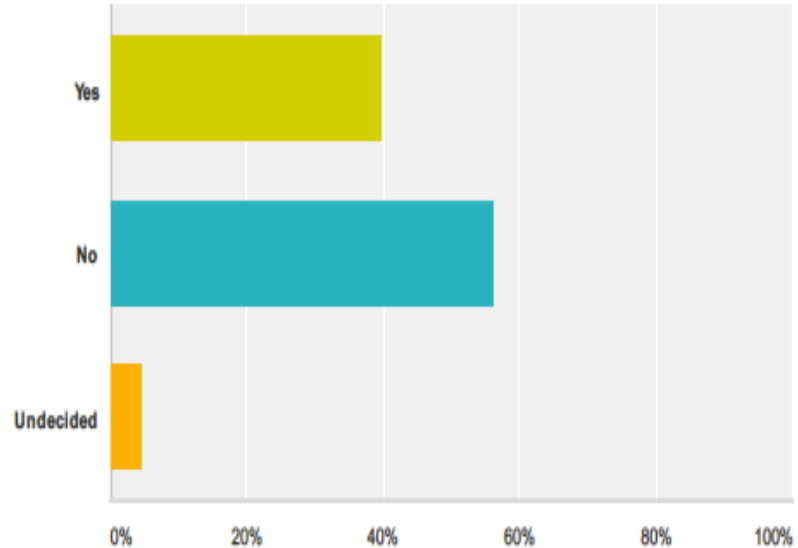
