




2018 PMI SFBAC Annual Survey

Overall, how satisfied were you with the schedule and format of the Events?





How satisfied were you with the location of the Events?



How often do you prefer that the chapter communicate to you regarding various events?


What is your preference to receive information regarding the chapter activities?


Revenue Collection By Events 2018



- Focus at career fairs is to provide opportunity to bring awareness to certification, project management resources, networking, and volunteer opportunities.








